
Step 3: Prepare your



Review Process – April to September

- Jury panels assess your entry against the judging criteria
- Winners are also automatically entered into the IAP2 International Awards
- A summary of any feedback or judges' comments can be made available after the announcement of the Winners in October (upon request)



If you are a finalist

Should you be shortlisted as a finalist, you will also be required to submit:

- A 30 second video outlining the engagement process of your project/organisation
- Artwork for an A1 sized Poster/Storyboard for display at the 2021 IAP2A Conference in October.
